Sasa was today's captain after her gutsy, goal scoring performance in that 4-1 victory against Bedwell. The Belles kicked off and went straight on the attack, and Sadie was unlucky to see her first strike on goal go marginally wide. However, within a minute, the same player did have the ball in the back of the net as her shot from the left hand edge of the area beat the Bury keeper to put the Belles a goal up. The Belles kept up the pressure with some lovely passing play and four minutes later they were 2 goals to the good as Sadie got her second when she latched on to a pass from Kinnari. It was all one way traffic as Sasa and Josephine controlled midfield and even Jess was pushing up from defence. Sadie, Kinnari and Sasa all had chances to increase the lead but good keeping by the Bury stopper and some off target shooting denied them. Ten minutes gone and it was 3- 0, as Sadie yet again powered in a shot from the edge of the box, after more good work from Kinnari. A minute later and Sadie hit hers and the Belles fourth, after running through a shell shocked Bury defence. Emily then made an appearance, and straight away her speed and her eye for playing the wide ball, caused problems for Bury as the Belles added another dimension to their game. With 20 mins on the clock, the Belles went 5 up as Sadie hit the back of the net again, after one of Emily's breaks down the flank and two minutes before the half time Sadie knocked in number 6, a double hat trick before the end of the first half. Poor Nicole, in goal for the Belles, remained a chilly spectator for most of that time only touching the ball on a couple of occasions.

Without the power of Sadie up front, the Belles were having to use the width of the pitch, their speed and their superior passing to create chances, and they were doing this so well that nearly every player had at least one chance to score with Ciara going close on a couple of occasions and Meg and Jess also going close. Bury, to their credit didn't give up and a couple of times, following good passing moves, they managed to break through before being stopped by Josephine and Sadie, both now playing in defence or by Meg who came scrambling back from the heady heights of mid field. In the 42nd minute Emily scored yet again, with a well taken goal before Sasa grabbed her second with a goalmouth scramble in the 44th. Kinnari got herself on the score sheet again a minute later, staying calm whilst under pressure. With 2 minutes to go Emily got the Belles 12th goal of the game and notched her second successive hat trick after blasting a well taken corner from the ever impressive Jess past the helpless Bury keeper.

Another great performance by the girls again this week. The most pleasing aspect is that, although Sadie caused havoc in the first half with her brilliant six goal haul, when she went off the others didn't just switch off and sit on their lead, they found alternative options to get at goal and took their chances well with 3 players sharing the other goals and all but Nicole in goal having chances to add to the tally.
